

Through the Second Step Program, 2nd-4th grade students at Merriam Avenue School were trained on how to Recognize, Report and Refuse Bullying. As part of the program 4th grade students designed t-shirts with messages of kindness and respect. The Second Step Program is a social and emotional curriculum that includes units on skills for learning, empathy, emotion management, friendship skills and problem solving. Recognize, Report and Refuse Bullying is an important lesson for students in elementary school.
